# **Queensland Drug Warning**

### Pressed pill sold as oxycodone containing a strong nitazene

Protonitazene has been detected in Queensland in a **green, bear shaped pressed pill marked 'Y'** by the CheQpoint drug checking service in Bowen Hills, Brisbane. The pill was sold as oxycodone.

**Nitazenes** are a group of very strong opioids that work like heroin or fentanyl and can produce lifethreatening toxicity in small amounts.

#### **Toxic Effects**

The toxic effects of nitazenes are similar to other opioids and include:

- Sedation
- Coma
- Slow or obstructed breathing
- Respiratory failure that can lead to death.

These effects respond to naloxone, and it should be used if available (more information on accessing naloxone below).

#### **Information and Advice**

Queensland Health advises that if you suspect you have this tablet, **do not consume** and dispose of it safely.

## Seek medical attention immediately if you or someone you know experiences any toxic effects following drug use.

**Naloxone** will reverse an opioid overdose; it is available for free from registered pharmacies and services through the national Take Home Naloxone program. **Nitazene test strips** can be useful but are not entirely effective in screening for all nitazenes, they should be used with caution.
